



British Surfing – Eligibility Policy

Purpose:

The purpose of this document is to outline the Eligibility Policy for Athletes to qualify for the British Team

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1. Overview

1.1. Criteria:

- 1.1.1. In order to represent British Surfing at an International Event, athletes must satisfy ALL of the following criteria.
 - 1.1.1.1. Hold a valid British Passport.
 - 1.1.1.2. Be a current member of one of the Home Nations Federations (Surfing England, Channel Island Surfing Fed., Scottish Surfing Fed., Welsh Surfing Federation).
 - 1.1.1.3. Comply with the eligibility regulations of their home nation federation in order to compete in their national championships (qualification event for British Surfing Championships).
 - 1.1.1.4. Qualify through the stated selection process for any given British Team.
 - 1.1.1.5. Comply with entry regulations set out by International Organising Bodies (BOC, ISA, ESF).
 - 1.1.1.6. Declare any previous Doping Control Failures in any sport, and consent to random event drug testing.
- 1.1.2. Any appeals concerning eligibility will be considered by the Board of British Surfing. Their decision will be final.
