### MAIN PURPOSE:

The British Surfing Team Coach is responsible for the coaching the British Surfing team athletes and technical surfing elements allocated to them.

### OBJECTIVES:

To coordinate the coaching and technical/logistical elements to ensure:

1. A partnership with British Surfing to create strong leadership.
2. Agreed Event objectives are met.
3. The coordination of development plans for each athlete.
4. The coordination of athletes during training and competitive events.
5. To ensure the Squad (defined here as surfers and coaches) act as ambassadors for British Surfing.

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Working with British Surfing to ensure the smooth and disciplined running of the Team.
- Ensuring surfers are getting their equipment to the events.
- Coordinate the training and warm up plan for each surfer.

- Coordinate surfer support during training and competition in a fair and effective manner.
- Arranges and communicates logistics to ensure team members are where they should be.
- Ensures that appropriate coaching support is available for team members.
- Providing a Coaching Report, with individual feedback, to the Board within 2 weeks of the end of the event.

#### COMPETENCIES:

The Coach should demonstrate an ability to:

- Act in a professional and consistent manner that is fair, open and transparent.
- Plan athlete programmes and support.
- Set and work efficiently within agreed budgets.
- Able to work within the authority delegated by the British Surfing Board
- Lead a team.
- Make controlled responses in stressful situations.
- Sets high standards for self and others and is dissatisfied with average performance.

#### PRE REQUISITES:

- Experience of Coaching at international level.
- Additional training or updated training as required by British Surfing.
- Working knowledge of British Surfing, Olympic and UKsport requirements and expectations for athletes and the British team.
- Coaches should demonstrate experience in coaching teams or athletes at international sporting events.
