MAIN PURPOSE:

The British Surfing Team Manager is responsible for the welfare and co-ordination of athletes to and from events.

OBJECTIVES:

To coordinate the management and technical/logistical elements to ensure:

1. A partnership with British Surfing to create strong leadership.
2. Agreed Event objectives are met.
3. The coordination of personal coaches.
4. The coordination of athletes during training and competitive events.
5. To ensure the Squad (defined here as surfers and coaches) act as ambassadors for British Surfing.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Creation of development plan for the British Team throughout the calendar year dovetailing training and athlete appearances as required in between major events.
- Ensuring that the British Surfing policies and procedures are adhered to and followed.
- Creation of a budget and expenditure plan for forward looking events submitted to the board for approval in advance.

- Working with British Surfing to ensure the smooth and disciplined running of the Team.
- Coordinate surfer support during training and competition in a fair and effective manner.
- Arranges and communicates logistics to ensure team members are where they should be.
- Coordination of media streams during events to ensure British Surfing is suitably and positively represented.
- Providing a Management Report, with individual feedback, to the Board within 2 weeks of the end of the event.

COMPETENCIES:

The Manager should demonstrate an ability to:

- Act in a professional and consistent manner that is fair, open and transparent.
- Plan athlete programmes and support.
- Set and work efficiently within agreed budgets.
- Able to work within the authority delegated by the British Surfing Board
- Lead a team.
- Make controlled responses in stressful situations.
- Sets high standards for self and others and is dissatisfied with average performance.

PRE REQUISITES:

- Experience of Team Management at international level.
- Additional training or updated training as required by British Surfing.
- Working knowledge of British Surfing, Olympic and UKsport requirements and expectations for athletes and the British team.
- Managers should demonstrate experience in managing teams or athletes at international sporting events.
